



- Non-regulatory agency within Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs (EOEEA)
- Provides confidential onsite technical and compliance assistance to manufacturers, businesses, and institutions
- All OTA services are free of charge to any Massachusetts toxics user
- OTA has conducted approximately 3500 site visits at 1500 facilities, helping companies save millions of pounds of toxic chemicals and millions of dollars in operating costs
