Alternatives to Higher Hazard Substances

Halogenated Compounds (began with nPB)

VMSs (e.g. D5 and HMDS)

D-limonene



Results:

- D-limonene: not recommended to list
- HMDS: recommended to list due to flash point
- D5 and other VMSs : ongoing
- Halogenated compounds: ongoing
- Formaldehyde: recommended as HHS due to IARC 1 listing for Nasopharyngeal cancer

- Hydrofluoro ethers (HFEs)
