SOME ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF TURPA

- ◆ **Improved DEP regulations and policies that affect TUR Planners;**
- ◆ **Reduced fees and requirements for continuing education for maintaining TUR Planner certification;**
- ◆ **Obtained agreement from DEP that they would notify Planners in advance of renewal deadlines to avoid confusion;**
- ◆ **Established policy for treatment of Planners who may not be able to obtain credits by renewal deadline.**

BENEFITS OF BECOMING A TURPA MEMBER

- ◆ **Provides a pathway for staying on top of potential TURA issues as they develop;**
- ◆ **Membership meetings are informational sessions with speakers for specific TURA related issues: Resource Conservation – Energy/DOE and EOEEA, etc;**
