Consider the Options

- How can waste generated by daily activities be reduced?
 - Pursue opportunities internally and with suppliers
- Can unneeded materials be reused in their intended manner?
 - Internally or by another business
- How else could the "waste" by reused by others?
 - Input for the manufacturing of a different product
 - Material for arts and crafts projects
 - Maker activities or other learning opportunities

- Schools, non-profit organizations always appreciate resources
- Municipalities and local small businesses are also good outlets

Additional Reuse Activities at JM

- Donated used lab equipment to African charity
- Recycled 2.5 tons of nitrile gloves in 2 years
 - Partnered Kimberly-Clark's RightCycle
- Internal recycling of drums; first pass solvents
- Work with vendors that refurbish lab goods





Diversion Tips

- Relationships enable and support success
- Keep it simple local, organized, routine
- Avoid items that have liability risks
- Publicize partnerships inspire others









Management Buy-in and Support is Critical

- Prove the savings to management and finance to secure support
- Seek out the champions who believe in sustainability, recycling
- Use your company's environmental and sustainability programs, goals to give credence to your sustainability efforts
- When donating items, have legal team write up a Bill of Sale/Donation Receipt for equipment or goods
- Seek Purchasing department's support when considering new vendors with greener footprints
