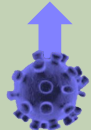


PERSON AS A HOST

SARS-CoV-2 can infect people and make some people sick with COVID-19. People with COVID-19 without symptoms may still be able to transmit the virus to others.



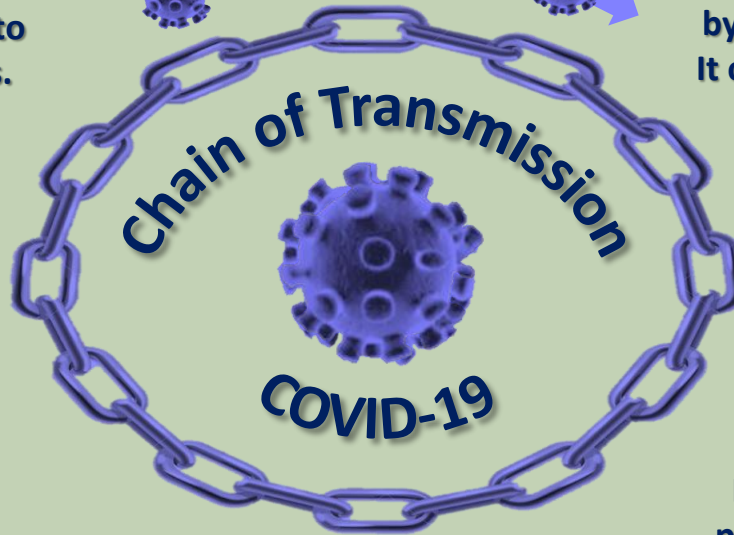
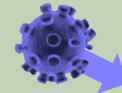
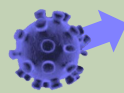
THE VIRUS ENTERS THE BODY

Eyes and respiratory system: nose and mouth



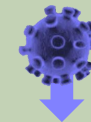
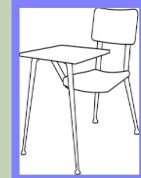
INFECTIOUS AGENT - SARS-CoV-2

is the Virus that causes the disease Covid-19



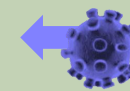
RESERVOIR

Where the virus lands on living and nonliving things. It survives outside the body for a length of time determined by conditions and type of surface. It only reproduces inside the body.

Infected person touches surfaces and people, and sneezes, coughs, sings, etc.

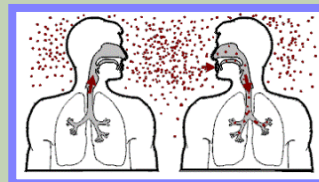


THE VIRUS IS TRANSPORTED TO NEW LOCATIONS
