The Quat Residue Group (QRG), operating under the auspices of the Household & Commercial Products Association's (HCPA) Ignite Solutions group, would like to submit the attached comments for consideration for the November 18, 2020 Toxics Use Reduction Science Advisory Board Meeting.

The QRG feels that these comments should be considered by the science advisory board because the comments describe the importance of quaternary ammonium compounds (ADBAC and DDAC specifically) as a public health tool, which is especially relevant during the COVID-19 pandemic. Additionally, they summarize the large and robust mammalian and environmental toxicology study database that substantiates the safe use of ADBAC and DDAC.
